RTR's Drive Your Triumph Day and 2024 Annual Meeting Saturday, February 10th By Mike Roe

Rye Livingston is with the Triumph Travelers Sports Car Club in Northern California, arguably the longest active Triumph Club in the world, having been founded in 1958. In 2016, he encouraged members of the club to drive their Triumphs on February 10th to celebrate Sir John Black's birthday. Sir John Black was the man who organized Standard's purchase of Triumph after WW II and went on to make the cars we enjoy driving today. Drive Your Triumph Day has gained momentum every year. Last year, Rye received over six hundred photos from all over the world: Scotland, Ireland, the UK, New Zealand, Australia, South Africa, Uruguay, Netherlands, Switzerland, Finland, Canada, Holland, Czech Republic, and of course the US.

The concept is straightforward: On February 10th, go for a drive in your Triumph. Take a scenic drive on a country road or out to lunch, to the market, to work, wherever. Go for a drive alone or in a group with your local Triumph Club; then take a photo. The photo is mainly of the car and the owner or passenger, if possible, ideally in front of a cool spot, landmark, scenic view or in your driveway.

Glenn Larson took the lead to organize a drive for RTR on Saturday, February 10. Once again, the starting point was at the River Road Shopping Center. Glenn planned a route that would take the group down Huguenot over the James River, then along Riverside Drive to enjoy the beautiful scenery, and then on to the Wilton House for a group photo. The Wilton House was built around 1753 and was home to several generation of the Randolph family until the Civil War, then passed through several owners before falling into receivership during the Great Depression. A group called the Colonial Dames of America (membership requires being a direct descendant of an ancestor who rendered "significant service" to the country before July 5, 1776) saved the home and moved it to its present location off River Road and looking over Williams Island. After the group photo, the Larsons offered to host the annual meeting and lunch at their home.

Though rain was forecast, it held off (for the most part) for the duration of the drive and lunch. We had ten Triumphs, a slight drop from 2023 (likely a result of the forecast). About two dozen members and their guests participated on the drive, then about another dozen or so RTR members and their guests joined us back at the Larson Home for the delicious repast laid out by Sue and Glenn Larson.

After lunch we held a short annual meeting to re-



view the slate of officers for 2024 and go through a high-level overview of events planned for 2024, then those stalwart souls who were brave enough to risk driving home in a torrent stayed a bit longer to hear the continuing saga of Glenn Larson's Stag. Thanks to the Larsons for organizing the tour and lunch once again!

RTR Tech TR6 Alternator Conversion By Mike Roe

For years, the alternator on my '76 TR6 has been weak in that it puts out only 13.2 volts, give or take, at speed. With any kind of load (lights, wipers, etc.) or at low speed, the voltage drops to the 12.8 volt range. At this voltage, you are barely keeping the battery charged and are likely discharging the battery at night or when it's raining.

Those who track these things will know that Triumph used a bewildering assortment of alternators, from Lucas 15 to 18 ACR. Some AC Delco units may have been installed, too. Not only are the Lucas units weak (~35 amps), but they are getting quite old by now, so their windings and electrics are becoming less and less reliable. To compound this, replacement alternators for my '76 TR6 (with air pump) are over \$300, if you can find one.


Since I have the engine of the TR apart for valve repair, I decided it was time to finally upgrade my alternator. A search of the web yielded many projects to upgrade to a GM "one wire" alternator, with either glowing or "don't ever try this" reviews. I surmised that there must have been a better option since the days these reviews were written and, sure enough, there is a company named BNR Parts on eBay that makes alternator upgrades for British cars and guarantees fitment with no modifications.



I sent a message through eBay to the vendor to confirm that the pulley is 1/2" for TR6 V-belt and not the smaller 3/8" width used on GT6 and Spitfire. He quickly confirmed that it was, so a purchase was made.

Since my TR6 is a later model (1976), I had the alternator mount that included the air pump (long since removed). You can't use this mount with the new alternator as it is bigger and interferes with the fender. Fortunately, through the good graces of Eric Crenshaw, I was able to purchase an earlier bracket.

With the new (old) bracket installed, I next installed the alternator to check alignment. It's important to have all pulleys aligned to minimize wear on the belt. I needed a 1.5" spacer on the bottom pivot to bring the pulley in alignment with the others. For



the tension bracket, I was pleased to find that the one I had, once swapped from under the alternator to above, fit perfectly.

BNR advertised "no modifications needed" and they were right; the plug fits perfectly into the rear of the new alternator.

Red with yellow tracer is the ignition light, which goes to the small spade. This excites the field windings until the alternator generates a higher voltage than the battery, at which point the ignition light goes out. The larger gauge red wire goes to the large spade and carries the charging current. The '76 TR6 has another



smaller gauge red wire, but this is connected to the larger red wire in the loom so it does not need to be connected.

With everything hooked up, the ignition light comes on with the key in the run position, and with the engine running the ignition light goes out and I now have 14.2 volts, which is right where you want to be to charge the battery. Since the



output of the new alternator is almost 3x the original, and I did not upgrade my charge wire, you need



to be careful not to try to charge a fully depleted battery using only the alternator or add significant loads to the circuit, as you could overload the existing wiring.




